## Show Tips

- ◆ Do not over groom your alpaca. It disturbs the crimp and lock structure of the fleece. You will do better if you pick the fleece, even though it may not be perfectly clean.
- ◆ Practice with your alpaca. Familiarize having the fleece examined at the shoulder, middle side, and rump. Be prepared to show your alpaca's teeth to the judge.
- ◆ Walk your alpaca around before the class to help the animal relax and loosen up. Before the show begins, walk in the ring to get the alpaca use to the surface.
- ◆ Be sure that your alpaca's halter fits properly. If you are unsure, ask for help. An alpaca supply vendor will be at the show if you need a halter.
- ◆ Do not be afraid to ask for help or advice from your fellow exhibitors; alpaca people are a friendly, helpful bunch.
- ◆ Watch the judge. Smile and have fun!
