Show Registration and Payment of Entry Fees: All payments, whether by credit card, debit card or check shall be for the 2025 Buckeye Alpaca Fall Fest, November 1-2, 2025. Entries are not final until payment has been received. Stalling location will be based on time and date of payment postmark or submission. All checks are to be made payable to Buckeye Alpaca Show.

<u>Cancellation Policy:</u> Refunds shall be made in full for cancellations received **prior to** October 7th, 2025.

Refunds made for cancellations received from October 7, 2025, to October 21, 2025, will be charged a \$35 fee per animal and \$15 fee per walking fleece class entered in the show.

No refunds will be made for cancellations received after October 21, 2025, or for No Shows.

All cancellations must be made in writing. All eligible refunds will be processed after the show.

<u>Substitution Policy:</u> Substitutions may be made to show registrations, animals or walking fleece class entries, subject to the payment of a substitution fee of \$25.00 per animal or \$10.00 per walking fleece class entry.

COVID19 SAFETY PROCEDURES:
